
Beautiful Savior God

Song placement suggestion: Call to Worship or special engagement.

Bible verses, Romans 6: 1- 4. Study chapters 6 and 7.

Paul explains how the new covenant between God and people is because of Christ's sacrifice. Our continual sinful selves and ways of missing the mark with God are buried with Christ! We are no longer slaves to that sin. Jesus rose from the dead to seal this new covenant.

Paul's knowledge of the law and the prophets and the *previous covenant* explains how the letter of the law kept us



strapped to the identity of sin. The laws were written on stone and paper and created a system where people were beholden to a continual cycle of meaningless sacrifices.

Instead, Jesus told us that God wrote his law on our hearts. Then, He rose from the dead. Not for His sake, but for ours so we can share in new life.

He conquered death. He conquered *our* continual cycle of death and repression under the weight of guilt and sin and a futile system of trying to get right with God.

Now we live because He lives. We are no longer under law, but under grace. We are now free to live, unhindered, the life God has designed for each of us.
